- The Board erred in finding that claims 27 and 28 of the '978 patent are not unpatentable under 35 U.S.C. § 103(a) based on Krtolica, Kirchhoff, and Hosner; and
- any other issues decided adversely to Petitioner in an order, decision, ruling, or opinion underlying or supporting the Final Written Decision.
