PETITIONER'S NOTICE OF APPEAL 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a) Please take notice that Petitioner Valve Corporation ("Valve") hereby appeals under 35 U.S.C. §§ 141(c), 142 and 319, and 37 C.F.R §§ 90.2 and 90.3 to the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit from the Final Written Decision on Remand (Paper 87), entered January 26, 2023, in the above-captioned *inter partes* review proceeding before the Patent Trial and Appeal Board (PTAB) of the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO). The present notice of appeal is being filed in the USPTO within the sixty-three (63) days prescribed under 37 C.F.R. § 90.3(b)(1) and is therefore timely under 35 U.S.C. § 142.

In accordance with 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a)(3)(ii), Valve hereby identifies the expected issues on appeal to include, but are not necessarily limited to:

- Whether the PTAB erred in finding Valve did not demonstrate that claims 18, 19, 21, 26, and 29 would have been obvious over the combination of Burns, David, *Review: Scuf Xbox 360 Controller* (published October 20, 2010 at https://www.xboxer360.com/features/reviewscuf-xbox-360controller/) ("Burns") with U.S. Patent No. D419,985 ("LaCelle");
- Whether the PTAB erred in finding Valve did not demonstrate that claim 21 would have been obvious over the combination of Burns with U.S. Patent No. D711,881 ("Bellinghausen"); and

- Whether the PTAB erred in finding Valve did not demonstrate that claim 26 would have been obvious over the combination of Burns and U.S. Patent No. D502,468 ("Knight");
- 4. Whether the PTAB erred in any finding supporting or relating to the aforementioned claims and grounds; and
- All other interlocutory orders and decisions made during the abovecaptioned *inter partes* review proceedings necessary to the PTAB's Final Written Decision on Remand from which the present appeal is taken.
