Notice is hereby given, pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a), that Patent Owner, WESTERNGECO LLC, hereby appeals and/or petitions for a writ of mandamus to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit from the Final Written Decision entered on December 15, 2015 (Paper No. 100) (the "Final Written Decision"), the Decision on Request for Rehearing entered on March 17, 2016 (Paper No. 105) (the "Decision on Rehearing"), and from all underlying orders, decisions, rulings and opinions regarding U.S. Patent No. 7,162,967 ("the '967 Patent").

- The construction of claims 1 and 15;
- Secondary considerations of non-obviousness;
- Petitioners' failure to identify real parties-in-interest;
- Whether Petitioners are in privity with each other;

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- Whether the Petition was time-barred under 35 U.S.C. § 315(b);
- Whether collateral estoppel and res judicata barred ION Geophysical Corporation's and ION International S.A.R.L.'s joinder to the proceeding;
- The Board's denial of additional discovery regarding real party-ininterest and privity; and
- Whether Patent Owner was afforded due process in this proceeding.
