### PETITIONER SHINN FU'S NOTICE OF APPEAL

Pursuant to 35 U.S.C. §§ 141-142 and 37 C.F.R. §§ 90.2-90.3, notice is hereby given that Petitioners Shinn Fu Company of America, Inc. and Shinn Fu Corporation (collectively "Shinn Fu") hereby appeal to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit from the Final Written Decision entered by the U.S. Patent & Trademark Office on April 22, 2016 (Paper 24) granting Tire Hanger Corporation's Motion to Amend (Paper 15), substituting new claims 6-10 for original claims 1-5 of U.S. Pat. No. 6,681,897.

In accordance with 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a)(3)(ii), Shinn Fu further indicates that the issues on appeal include, but are not limited to: (1) whether the USPTO committed reversible error by failing to address Shinn Fu's arguments regarding the new claims; (2) whether the USPTO committed reversible error when considering the new claims by focusing only on modified combinations of the prior art used in the institution decision; and (3) whether Tire Hanger carried its burden of proving that its new claims are patentable.

Shinn Fu reserves the right to challenge any finding or determination supporting or relating to the issues listed above (as well as to challenge the lack of proper findings and determinations), and to challenge any other issues decided adversely to Shinn Fu in the Final Written Decision or in any other order, decision,

ruling, or opinion underlying the Final Written Decision.

Simultaneous with this submission, one copy of this Notice of Appeal is being filed with the Clerk of the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit, together with the requisite docketing fee in the amount of \$500. In addition, a copy of this Notice of Appeal is being filed with the Patent Trial and Appeal Board and served upon counsel of record for Tire Hanger.
