The Patent Owner hereby gives notice that it appeals to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit from the Final Written Decision entered by the Patent Trial and Appeal Board on May 10, 2016 (Paper 60) and from all underlying orders, decisions, rulings and opinions.

In accordance with 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a)(3)(ii), the Patent Owner indicates that the issues on appeal include the Board's determinations of unpatentability of claims 9, 14, 17, 19, and 21-23 of U.S. Patent No. 6,926,544, including the determination under 35 U.S.C. § 103 of obviousness over U.S. Patent No. 6,480,390 ("Matsumiya") (Ex. 1003) in view of U.S. Patent No. 6,829,672 ("Deng") (Ex. 1005) and the determination under 35 U.S.C. § 103 of obviousness over U.S. Patent No. 6,522,534 ("Wu") (Ex. 1006) in view of U.S. Design Patent No. 199,589 ("Hoogesteger") (Ex. 1008). The Patent Owner also indicates that the issues on appeal may include whether the Board arrived at correct interpretations of the above-listed claims and their respective base claims, including claim 8 and, where applicable, claim 11, of the '544 Patent; whether the Board followed proper procedures in reaching its interpretations, including, for example, its interpretation of "on" and "on at least one side of the case," with fair notice to the Patent Owner

and in compliance with the requirements of the Administrative Procedures Act; and whether the Board's institution decision (Paper 7) was correct and lawful.

Simultaneously with this submission, a copy of this Notice of Appeal is being filed electronically with the Patent Trial and Appeal Board. In addition, the required number of copies of this Notice of Appeal is being filed with the Clerk's Office of the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit, and the filing fee is or will be timely paid via pay.gov.
