Petitioner Microsoft Corporation's Notice of Appeal

Pursuant to 35 U.S.C. §§ 141, 142, and 319, and in accordance with 37 C.F.R. §§ 90.2-90.3, Petitioner Microsoft Corporation ("Microsoft") appeals to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit from the Final Written Decision of the Patent Trial and Appeal Board ("Board") entered on August 11, 2016 in IPR2015-00483 (Paper No. 81) ("Final Written Decision"), and from all underlying findings, determinations, rulings, opinions, orders, and decisions regarding the *inter partes* reviews (IPR2015-00483 and the IPRs consolidated and/or joined with it) of U.S. Patent No. 5,894,554 (the "554 Patent").

In accordance with 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a)(3)(ii), Microsoft states that the issues on appeal include, but are not limited to: the Board's determination that claims 12-49 of the 554 Patent have not been shown to be unpatentable; the Board's construction of those claims; the Board's consideration of the expert testimony, prior art, and other evidence in the record; and the Board's factual findings, conclusions of law, or other determinations supporting or related to those issues, as well as all other issues decided adversely to Microsoft in any orders, decisions, rulings, and opinions.

This Notice of Appeal is being e-filed with the Clerk's Office for the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit, along with payment of the required docketing fees. In addition, a copy of this Notice of Appeal is being filed simultaneously with the Patent Trial and Appeal Board.
