Notice is hereby given, pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a), that Patent Owner, OneSubsea IP UK Limited, hereby appeals and/or petitions for a writ of mandamus to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit from the Final Written Decision entered on June 29, 2017 (Paper No. 29) (the "Final Written Decision"), and from all underlying orders, decisions, rulings and opinions regarding U.S. Patent No. 8,776,893 ("the '893 Patent").

In accordance with 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a)(3)(ii), Patent Owner further indicates that the issues on appeal may include the following, as well as any underlying findings, determinations (including claim constructions), rulings, decisions, opinions, or other related issues:

- The Board's holding that claims 1, 2, 4, 6–9, 11, 15, and 17 are anticipated by Kelly;
- The Board's holding that claims 1, 2, 4–9, 11–15 and 17–19 are rendered obvious by Kelly in view of Andersen;
- The construction of claims 1, 2, 4–9, 11–15, and 17–19;
- Whether Patent Owner was afforded due process in this proceeding; and
- Whether the Patent Trial and Appeal Board exceeded its statutory authority.
