Circuit ("CAFC") from the Final Written Decision ("FWD") in this *inter*partes review ("IPR") dated August 29, 2017 and from all orders, decisions,

For the limited purpose of providing the Director with the information requested in 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a)(3)(ii), issues on appeal may include, but are not limited to: the United States Patent and Trademark Office's ("USPTO") Patent Trial and Appeal Board's (PTAB) determination that claims 20, 33, 35, and 36 of United States Patent No. 8,717,303 ("the '303 Patent") have been shown by a preponderance of the evidence to be unpatentable; the PTAB's construction of terms and phrases appearing in those claims, including the terms "finger flick," "recognized," and "derived from"; the PTAB's denial of Patent Owner's request to exclude certain evidence based on Patent Owner's List of New Matter Submitted with Petitioners' Reply; the PTAB's consideration and evaluation of the expert testimony, prior art,

and other evidence of record; and any PTAB finding or determination supporting or relating to such determinations of unpatentability, including but not limited to claim construction issues, obviousness issues, PTAB findings that conflict with the evidence of record and are not supported by substantial evidence, as well as all other issues decided adversely to Patent Owner in any orders, decisions, rulings and/or opinions. The issues on appeal may also include the constitutionality of the *inter partes* review proceeding as raised in *Oil States Energy Services v. Greene's Energy Group, et al.*, Case No. 16-712 (2017) that the PTAB's findings in this proceeding and this proceeding itself violate due process.

Patent Owner reserves the right to challenge any finding or determination supporting or relating to the issues listed above and to challenge any other issues decided adversely to Patent Owner by the PTAB in this proceeding.
