Pursuant to 35 U.S.C. §§ 141, 142, and 319, and in accordance with 37 C.F.R. §§ 90.2-90.3, Patent Owner Smart Skins LLC appeals to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit from the Final Written Decision of the Patent Trial and Appeal Board entered on June 21, 2017 (Paper No. 27)<sup>1</sup> in IPR2016-00404, and from all underlying findings, determinations, rulings, opinions, orders, and decisions regarding the *inter partes* review.

In accordance with 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a)(3)(ii), Patent Owner states that the issues on appeal may include, but are not limited to:

- (1) the final written decision of the Patent Trial and Appeal Board finding claims 1, 12, 13, 15, 23, and 24 of U.S. Pat. No. 7,079,864 unpatentable, the factual bases underlying the Board's legal conclusions, and the sufficiency of the Board's analysis and factfindings regarding the same;
- (2) any other issues decided adversely to Patent Owner in any orders, decisions, rulings, and/or opinions; and
- (3) whether *inter partes* review violates the Constitution, including but not limited to by extinguishing private property rights through a non-
