PETITIONERS' NOTICE OF APPEAL

Pursuant to 35 U.S.C. §§ 141, 142, and 319, and in accordance with 37 C.F.R. §§ 90.2-90.3, Petitioners appeal to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit from the Decision on Remand of the Patent Trial and Appeal Board (“Board”) entered on February 14, 2020, and all underlying findings, determinations, rulings, opinions, orders, and decisions regarding the *inter partes* review of U.S. Patent No. 7,516,177 B2 (“’177 patent”). A copy of the Decision on Remand is attached.

Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a)(3)(ii), Petitioners state that the issues on appeal include, but are not limited to: the Board’s determination that Petitioners did not establish that claim 14 of the ’177 patent is unpatentable under 35 U.S.C. § 102 or § 103 by Eric Lease Morgan, *MyLibrary: A Model for Implementing a User-centered Customizable Interface to a Library’s Collection of Information Resources* (1999), and the Board’s factual findings, conclusions of law, or other determinations supporting or related to those issues, as well as other issues decided adversely to Petitioners in any orders, decisions, rulings, and opinions.

This Notice of Appeal is being e-filed with the Clerk’s Office for the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit, along with payment of the required docketing fees. In addition, a copy of this Notice of Appeal is being filed simultaneously with the Patent Trial and Appeal Board.
