PATENT OWNER'S NOTICE OF APPEAL

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a), that Patent Owner Carrum Technologies, LLC (“Patent Owner”) hereby appeals to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit from the Final Written Decision of the Patent Trial and Appeal Board, entered on July 15, 2020 (Paper No. 33). In accordance with 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a)(3)(ii). Patent Owner indicates that the issues on appeal include, but are not limited to the following:

1. Whether the PTAB erred in finding that Petitioner has shown by a preponderance of the evidence that Claims 1, 2, 7, and 9-11 of U.S. Patent No. 7,925,416 (“the ’416 Patent”) are unpatentable.
2. Whether the PTAB erred in finding that Petitioner has shown by a preponderance of the evidence that Claims 1, 2, 7, and 9 are unpatentable under 35 U.S.C. § 103(a) over U.S. Patent No. 6,675,094 (“Russell”), U.S. Patent No. 6,627,756 (“Fukada”), and Japanese Patent Application No. JP H05-36000 (“Mazda”).
3. Whether the PTAB erred in finding that Petitioner has shown by a preponderance of the evidence that Claims 10 and 11 are unpatentable under 35 U.S.C. § 103(a) over U.S. Patent No. 5,508,929 (“Harada”), Russell, and Mazda.

Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 90.3(a)(1), this Notice of Appeal is timely, having been duly filed within 63 days after the Final Written Decision entered July 15, 2020.

Simultaneous with this submission, a copy of this Notice of Appeal is being filed by Priority Mail Express with the Director of the United States Patent and Trademark Office. In addition, this Notice of Appeal, along with the required docketing fees, are being filed with the Clerk's Office for the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit.
