Plaintiff, Ball Chain Manufacturing Co., Inc. ("BCM"), by and through the counsel,

Tashjian & Padian, hereby complains against defendant Bison Designs, LLC ("Defendant") and
alleges as follows:

INTRODUCTION

- 1. Among other things, BCM seeks a declaratory judgment that United States Patent Nos. D454,054 (the "'054 Patent"), D447,681 (the "'681 Patent"), D465,993 (the "'993 Patent"), D447,932 (the "'932 Patent"), D487,014 (the "'014 Patent") and D449,500 (the "'500 Patent") (collectively, the "Subject Patents"), allegedly owned by Defendant, are invalid and/or unenforceable. True and correct copies of the Subject Patents are attached hereto as **Exhibits A-F**, respectively.
- 2. Defendant, through its agents and otherwise, asserted in conversations with BCM and in correspondence to BCM and its counsel dated March 4, 2014, March 7, 2014 and

March10, 2014 that BCM's sales of certain metal accessories including but not limited to the "Star, circle, fish, dog bone, and heart shaped carabiners" and the "guitar shaped bottle opener" (collectively "Accused Products") infringe the Subject Patents and suggested that if BCM were to enter into a cooperative license agreement with Defendant "you may not have any interruption in your business deliveries." A true and correct copy of the e-mail correspondence between the parties is attached hereto as **Exhibit G**.

- 3. Defendants' actions give rise to a reasonable apprehension of suit on the part of BCM and a resulting case or controversy between the parties relating to the Subject Patents.
- 4. The Accused Products offered in the US market do not infringe any of the claims of the Subject Patents.
- 5. Accordingly, BCM asks this Court to declare the Subject Patents invalid and unenforceable, and further to declare that BCM's Accused Products do not infringe the Subject Patents.

THE PARTIES

- 6. BCM is a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York, with its principal place of business at 741 South Fulton Avenue, Mount Vernon, New York 10550.
- 7. Upon information and belief, Defendant is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Colorado, with its principal place of business at 735 South Lincoln Street, Longmont, Colorado 80501.

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

8. This Court has original jurisdiction over the subject matter of these claims pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1331 (Federal Question), 1338(a) (Patents and Unfair Competition),

and 28 U.S.C. §§ 2201(a) (Declaratory Judgment), and by virtue of 28 U.S.C. § 1338(b), and supplemental jurisdiction, 28 U.S.C. § 1367.

- 9. Venue is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1391(a) and 1391(b).
- 10. Upon information and belief, Defendant conducts continuous, regular and systematic business within the State of New York, has contracted to supply goods or services within the State of New York directly through sale of product on its website and through retailers such as REI and Petco, and has otherwise purposefully availed itself of the privileges and benefits of the laws of the State of New York.

FACTS

- 11. On March 4, 2014, Bill Taubner, Vice President of BCM, was contacted by Brian Kelleghan of Defendant by telephone. Mr. Kelleghan told Mr. Taubner that upon viewing BCM's website, he had noticed several carabiners and a bottle opener that he believed infringed Defendant's patents. He suggested that BCM might be willing to enter into a license agreement to license Defendant's design patents in order for BCM to continue selling the Accused Products. See Exhibit G.
- 12. On March 4, 2014, Mr. Kelleghan again contacted Mr. Taubner by e-mail. Mr. Kelleghan's e-mail stated that "I have found it easier to make a direct contact to the decision maker in a company that appears to be inadvertently infringing our patents rather than sending a cease and desist letter without notice." *See* Exhibit G.
- 13. Mr. Kelleghan's March 4, 2014 e-mail also mentioned that "I do have experience doing this 66 times since 2001." *See* Exhibit G.

- Mr. Kelleghan's March 4, 2014 e-mail enclosed a list of Defendant's patents and mentioned that "I see several products offered in your product line that are exact copies of our designs." See Exhibit G.
- 15. Mr. Kelleghan's March 4, 2014 e-mail further suggested that if BCM were to enter into a cooperative license agreement with Defendant "you may not have any interruption in your business deliveries." *See* Exhibit G.
- 16. On March 5, 2014, Mr. Taubner e-mailed Mr. Kelleghan and asked him to "[p]lease identify which of [BCM's] products you deem infringes your patents so that we may respond to these allegations." *See* Exhibit G.
- 17. On March 7, 2014, Mr. Kelleghan responded to Mr. Taubner, stating in part as follows:

I didn't do an extensive view of your website but only looked at two pages that were enough to start our discussions.

I saw infringing carabiners and a bottle opener. I have patents on Star, circle, fish, dog bone, and heart shaped carabiners. And I have a patent on the guitar shaped bottle opener I saw on your site too.

See Exhibit G.

- 18. Mr. Taubner responded to Mr. Kelleghan's March 7, 2014 e-mail on March 9, 2014 by asking that Mr. Kelleghan "please direct all future correspondence to our lawyer, Gerald Padian gpadian@tashpad.com." See Exhibit G.
- 19. On March 7, 2014, counsel for BCM sent a letter to Mr. Kelleghan by e-mail and regular mail, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit H**, in response to Defendants' accusations of patent infringement by BCM.
 - 20. Counsel's March 7, 2014 letter to Mr. Kelleghan stated as follows:

We have reviewed your various design patents, most of which are for carabiners in the shape of obvious and basic symbols. There does not appear to be anything novel about your designs, and therefore there is a very high likelihood that in any subsequent litigation, re-examination or review of your patents they would be found to be invalid due to, inter alia, obviousness and/or on the basis of prior art.

Notwithstanding the above, BCM does not manufacture the subject carabiners and has not sold any carabiners in any of the shapes allegedly covered by your design patents. BCM has removed the subject carabiners from its website and is not marketing or selling same.

See Exhibit H.

- 21. On March 10, 2014 at 12:21 a.m. EDT, Mr. Kelleghan e-mailed Mr. Taubner and Mr. Padian. Mr. Kelleghan failed to address the March 7, 2014 letter and instead suggested that "Bill and I have a conversation regarding licensing possibilities including his continued sales of our designs...." See Exhibit G.
- 22. Mr. Kelleghan's March 10, 2014 e-mail also raised the possibility of litigation. See Exhibit G.
- 23. On March 10, 2014 at 9:33 a.m. EDT, Mr. Padian again e-mailed Mr. Kelleghan, forwarding a copy of the March 7, 2014 letter and stating "we await your response to the enclosed correspondence." A copy of this e-mail is attached hereto as **Exhibit I**.
- 24. To date, Mr. Kelleghan has failed to respond to the substance of the March 7, 2014 letter.
- 25. Defendant's actions give rise to a reasonable apprehension of suit on the part of BCM and a resulting case or controversy between the parties relating to the Subject Patents.
- 26. While BCM does not manufacture the Accused Products and sales of the Accused Products have been *de minimis*, if any, BCM has taken meaningful preparations to market the Accused Products for sale, including but not limited paying for samples of the Accused Product

from the manufacturer, determining pricing for the Accused Product, and advertising the Accused Product on BCM's website.

- 27. The Accused Products offered in the US market do not infringe any of the claims of the Subject Patents.
- 28. The Subject Patents are, upon information and belief, invalid for failure to satisfy the requirements for patentability of one or more of the sections of the Patent Act, Title 35, United States Code (hereinafter "35 U.S.C.").
- 29. The Subject Patents are, upon information and belief, invalid for failure to meet the conditions of patentability of one or more of the subsections of 35 U.S.C. § 102.
- 30. The Subject Patents are, upon information and belief, invalid for failure to meet the conditions of patentability of one or more of the subsections of 35 U.S.C. § 103.
- 31. The prior art so limits and restricts the scope of the Subject Patents' claims that BCM and its customers cannot be considered to have infringed Defendant's rights.

FIRST CLAIM FOR RELIEF DECLATORY JUDGMENT OF NON INFRINGEMENT OF US PATENT NO. D454,054

- 32. BCM hereby incorporates all of the preceding allegations of this Complaint into the First Claim of Relief as though set forth fully herein.

 - 115. Wherefore, BCM prays for judgment as set forth hereinafter.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, BCM prays for the following relief:

- A. That the Court declare that BCM did not, does not and has not infringed, directly, contributorily, or by inducement, the Subject Patents;
- B. That the Court declare that the Subject Patents are invalid;
- C. That the Court declare that the Subject Patents are unenforceable;
- D. That Defendant, its respective officers, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys, and all others in active concert or participation with Defendant, and each of them, be preliminarily and permanently enjoined and restrained from:

• From making any claims to any person or entity that BCM 's products infringe the Subject Patents;

• From interfering with, or threatening to interfere with, the manufacture, sale, license, distribution, or use of the Accused Products by BCM, its allied parties, suppliers, distributors, customers, licensees, successors or assigns, and others;

From instituting or prosecuting any lawsuit or proceeding, placing in issue
the right of BCM, its allied parties, suppliers, distributors, customers,
licensees, successors or assigns, and others to make, use, or sell the
Accused Products;

E. That this Court award BCM its reasonable attorneys' fees and costs of suit herein; and

F. That this Court grant BCM such other and further relief as the Court deems appropriate.

DEMAND FOR JURY TRIAL

BCM hereby demands a trial by jury in this action.






























