COMPLAINT

For its Complaint, Plaintiff Visual Memory LLC ("Visual Memory"), by and through the undersigned counsel, alleges as follows:

THE PARTIES

1. Visual Memory is a Delaware limited liability company with a place of business located in Dallas, Texas.
2. Defendant EMC Corporation is a Massachusetts corporation with, upon information and belief, a place of business located in Hopkinton, Massachusetts.
3. Upon information and belief, Defendant has done business in the state of Delaware and it has offered for sale and sold products in Delaware.

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

4. This action arises under the Patent Act, 35 U.S.C. § 1 *et seq.*
5. Subject matter jurisdiction is proper in this Court under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1331 and 1338.
6. Upon information and belief, Defendant conducts substantial business in this forum, directly or through intermediaries, including: (i) at least a portion of the infringements alleged herein; and (ii) regularly doing or soliciting business, engaging in other persistent courses

of conduct and/or deriving substantial revenue from goods and services provided to individuals in this district.

7. Venue is proper in this district pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1391(b), (c) and 1400(b).

THE PATENT-IN-SUIT

8. On February 15, 2000, United States Patent No. 6,026,027 (the "'027 patent"), entitled "Flash Memory System Having Memory Cache," was duly and lawfully issued by the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office. A true and correct copy of the '027 patent is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

9. Visual Memory is the assignee and owner of the right, title and interest in and to the '027 patent, including the right to assert all causes of action arising under said patent and the right to any remedies for infringement of it.

COUNT I – INFRINGEMENT OF U.S. PATENT NO. 6,026,027

10. Visual Memory repeats and realleges the allegations of paragraphs 1 through 9 as if fully set forth herein.

11. Without license or authorization and in violation of 35 U.S.C. § 271(a), Defendant is liable for infringement of the '027 patent by making, using, importing, offering for sale, and/or selling memory storage systems, including, but not limited to EMC FAST Cache, such as, but without limitation, VNX5100, VNX5300, VNX5500, VNX5700 and VNX7500, covered by one or more claims of the '027 patent.

12. Visual Memory is entitled to recover from Defendant the damages sustained by Visual Memory as a result of Defendant's infringement of the '027 patent in an amount subject to proof at trial, which, by law, cannot be less than a reasonable royalty, together with interest and costs as fixed by this Court under 35 U.S.C. § 284.

JURY DEMAND

Visual Memory hereby demands a trial by jury on all issues so triable.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Visual Memory requests that this Court enter judgment against Defendant as follows:

- A. An adjudication that Defendant has infringed the '027 patent;
- B. An award of damages to be paid by Defendant adequate to compensate Visual Memory for Defendant's infringement of the '027 patent and any continuing or future infringement through the date such judgment is entered, including interest, costs, expenses and an accounting of all infringing acts including, but not limited to, those acts not presented at trial;
- C. A declaration that this case is exceptional under 35 U.S.C. § 285, and an award of Visual Memory's reasonable attorneys' fees; and
- D. An award to Visual Memory of such further relief at law or in equity as the Court deems just and proper.
