Plaintiff Flowrider Surf, Ltd. and Surf Waves, Ltd. hereby appeal to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit the judgment entered May 8, 2018 (ECF No. 240), and from the order of May 26, 2017 granting Defendant Pacific Surf Design, Inc.'s Motion to Dismiss U.S. Patent 6,491,589 for Lack of Subject Matter Jurisdiction (ECF No. 222). This notice divests this court of further jurisdiction. Griggs v. Provident Consumer Discount Co., 459 U.S. 56, 58 ("The filing of a notice of appeal is an event of jurisdictional significance—it confers jurisdiction to the court of appeals and divests the district court of its control of those aspects of those aspects of the case involved in the appeal.").
