NOTICE OF APPEAL

Notice is hereby given that Hamamatsu Photonics K.K. and Hamamatsu Corporation (collectively, “Hamamatsu”), Defendants in the case captioned above, hereby appeal to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit from the final judgment entered in this action in the United States District Court for the District of Massachusetts on July 26, 2019 (D.I. 804), and from any and all judgments, orders, opinions, and findings (interlocutory or otherwise), pertinent or ancillary to the foregoing, including but not limited to:

(1) Order on Plaintiffs’ Motion for Equitable Relief (D.I. 801), dated July 25, 2019, granting ownership of the Disputed Patents¹ to Plaintiffs, injunctive relief related to breach of contract, and injunctive relief related to U.S. Patent No. 8,080,467;

(2) Order on Defendants’ Motion for Judgment as a Matter of Law (D.I. 797), dated July 25, 2019, denying Defendants’ renewed motions for judgment as a matter of law regarding

the statute of limitations, unjust enrichment damages beyond January 11, 2015, and willful infringement;

(3) Memorandum and Order on Claim Construction (D.I. 251), dated September 7, 2017; and

(4) Order on Plaintiffs' Motion for Pre-Judgment Interest and Post-Judgment Interest (D.I. 803), dated July 25, 2019, granting prejudgment interest to Plaintiffs.

Payment of the required fee of \$505, representing the \$500 for docketing a case on appeal specified in 28 U.S.C. § 1913, and the filing fee of \$5 for filing a notice of appeal specified in 28 U.S.C. § 1917, is being paid contemporaneously with the filing of this Notice of Appeal to the Clerk of this Court pursuant to Fed. R. App. P. 3(e).
