**HALO ELECTRONICS, INC.’S NOTICE
OF APPEAL**

18 Pursuant to Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure 3 and 4, notice is hereby given that
19 Plaintiff Halo Electronics, Inc. (“Halo”) in the above-named case hereby appeals to the United
20 States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit from the Judgment entered on March 15, 2021
21 (Dkt. No. 650) and each and every part thereof, including any and all orders, decisions, findings,
22 and rulings (whether oral or written) that are adverse to Halo in whole or in part, including but not
23 limited to the District Court’s order and ruling Denying Plaintiff’s Motion for Pre-Judgment
24 Interest and a Damages Trial.

25 Halo files this Notice of Appeal in an abundance of caution because there has yet to be a
26 final judgment after this case was remanded from the Supreme Court. In particular, Halo filed a
27 motion seeking post-judgment interest, and that motion has never been acted on—leaving an
28 undecided issue, and thus no final judgment. But the district court was convinced that there was a
final judgment, so Halo seeks review of that ruling and is considering the most efficient way, for
the parties and the Court, to do so.
