PLAINTIFF'S ORIGINAL COMPLAINT

Plaintiff Wolf Run Hollow LLC ("Plaintiff"), by and through its undersigned counsel, files this Original Complaint against Texas Bank; The First National Bank of Hughes Springs; T Bank, National Association; First Financial Bank, National Association; Lubbock National Bank; Farmers and Merchants Bank; Titan Bank, N.A.; The City National Bank of Taylor; Texas First Bank; and Union State Bank (collectively "Defendants") as follows:

NATURE OF THE ACTION

1. This is a patent infringement action to stop Defendants' infringement of Plaintiff's United States Patent No. 6,115,817 entitled "Methods and Systems for Facilitating Transmission of Secure Messages Across Insecure Networks" (the "'817 patent"; a copy of

which is attached hereto as Exhibit A). Plaintiff is the exclusive licensee of the '817 patent with respect to the Defendants. Plaintiff seeks injunctive relief and monetary damages.

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

13. This action arises under the Patent Laws of the United States, 35 U.S.C. § 1 *et seq.*, including 35 U.S.C. §§ 271, 281, 283, 284, and 285. This Court has subject matter jurisdiction over this case for patent infringement under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1331 and 1338(a).

Upon information and belief, each Defendant has committed patent infringement in the State of Texas and in the Eastern District of Texas, has contributed to patent infringement in the State of Texas and in the Eastern District of Texas, and/or has induced others to commit patent infringement in the State of Texas and in the Eastern District of Texas. Each Defendant solicits customers in the State of Texas and in the Eastern District of Texas. - 28. Each Defendant's aforesaid activities have been without authority and/or license from Plaintiff.
- 29. Plaintiff is entitled to recover from the Defendants the damages sustained by Plaintiff as a result of the Defendants' wrongful acts in an amount subject to proof at trial, which, by law, cannot be less than a reasonable royalty, together with interest and costs as fixed by this Court under 35 U.S.C. § 284.
- 30. Defendants' infringement of Plaintiff's exclusive rights under the '817 patent will continue to damage Plaintiff, causing irreparable harm for which there is no adequate remedy at law, unless enjoined by this Court.

JURY DEMAND

31. Plaintiff hereby requests a trial by jury pursuant to Rule 38 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Plaintiff respectfully requests that the Court find in its favor and against Defendants, and that the Court grant Plaintiff the following relief:

- A. An adjudication that one or more claims of the '817 patent have been infringed, either literally and/or under the doctrine of equivalents, by one or more

 Defendants and/or by others to whose infringement Defendants have contributed an/or by others whose infringement has been induced by Defendants;
- B. An award to Plaintiff of damages adequate to compensate Plaintiff for the
 Defendants' acts of infringement together with pre-judgment and post-judgment interest;
- C. That one or more of the Defendants' acts of infringement be found to be willful from the time that Defendants became aware of the infringing nature of their actions, which is the time of filing of Plaintiff's Original Complaint at the latest, and that the Court award treble damages for the period of such willful infringement pursuant to 35 U.S.C. § 284;
- D. A grant of permanent injunction pursuant to 35 U.S.C. § 283, enjoining the

 Defendants from further acts of (1) infringement, (2) contributory infringement,
 and (3) actively inducing infringement with respect to the claims of the '817

 patent;
- E. That this Court declare this to be an exceptional case and award Plaintiff its reasonable attorneys' fees and costs in accordance with 35 U.S.C. §285; and
- F. Any further relief that this Court deems just and proper.
