COMPLAINT

Plaintiff NEWELL OPERATING COMPANY ("Newell"), by its attorneys, as and for its Complaint herein against defendant ADVANCED AFFILIATES, INC. d/b/a DECORITE HARDWARE ("Decorite"), states as follows:

Nature of the Lawsuit

1. By these claims, Newell seeks to redress Decorite's infringement of Newell's patent rights. In particular, Decorite has unlawfully used Newell's inventions for various designs of pulls and knobs, in violation of Newell's rights.

The Parties

- 2. Plaintiff Newell is a Delaware corporation located in the Northern District of Illinois. Newell owns the patents in suit being infringed by Defendant.
- 3. Upon information and belief, Defendant Decorite is a New York corporation who is doing business in the State of Illinois and this judicial district, including the marketing and sale of the products that infringe Newell's patent rights.

Jurisdiction and Venue

- 4. This Court has jurisdiction pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1331 and 1338.
- 5. Venue is proper in this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1391(b)-(c) and 1400(b).

Decorite's Infringement of Newell's Patents

6. On August 29, 1995, the United States Patent and Trademark Office duly and legally issued United States Patent No. D361,707 (the "'707 patent"), called "Pull," a copy of which is attached as Exhibit A. Newell is the assignee and owner of the '707 Patent, which relates to an ornamental design for a pull.

- 7. On October 19, 1999, the United States Patent and Trademark Office duly and legally issued United States Patent No. D415,405 (the "'405 patent"), called "Knob," a copy of which is attached as Exhibit B. Newell is the assignee and owner of the '405 Patent, which patent relates to an ornamental design for a knob.
- 8. On February 6, 2001, the United States Patent and Trademark Office duly and legally issued United States Patent No. D437,202 (the "'202 patent"), called "Pull," a copy of which is attached as Exhibit C. Newell is the assignee and owner of the '202 Patent, which relates to an ornamental design for a pull.
- 9. On July 6, 1999, the United States Patent and Trademark Office duly and legally issued United States Patent No. D411,795 (the "'795 patent"), called "Knob," a copy of which is attached as Exhibit D. Newell is the assignee and owner of the '795 Patent, which relates to an ornamental design for a knob.
- 10. On August 31, 1999, the United States Patent and Trademark Office duly and legally issued United States Patent No. D413,248 (the "'248 patent"), called "Pull," a copy of which is attached as Exhibit E. Newell is the assignee and owner of the '248 Patent, which relates to an ornamental design for a pull.
- 11. On January 4, 2000, the United States Patent and Trademark Office duly and legally issued United States Patent No. D418,387 (the "'387 patent''), called "Knob," a copy of

which is attached as Exhibit F. Newell is the assignee and owner of the '387 Patent, which relates to an ornamental design for a knob.

- 12. On January 4, 2000, the United States Patent and Trademark Office duly and legally issued United States Patent No. D418,388 (the "'388 patent"), called "Pull," a copy of which is attached as Exhibit G. Newell is the assignee and owner of the '388 Patent, which relates to an ornamental design for a pull.
- 13. In violation of Newell's exclusive rights under the patent laws of the United States, Decorite has infringed and continues to infringe the '707, '405, '202, '795, '248, '387, and '388 Patents by using, making, offering for sale, and selling numerous knobs and pulls that embody the designs described and shown in the '707, '405, '202, '795, '248, '387, and '388 Patents, including without limitation Decorite model numbers 3030, 6464, 6954, and 6117.
- 14. By reason of Decorite's infringing activities, Newell has suffered, and will continue to suffer, substantial damages, in an amount to be proven at trial.
- 15. Decorite's conduct also has caused, and will continue to cause, Newell irreparable harm. Decorite's conduct is likely to continue unless it is enjoined from such conduct by this Court.
- 16. Decorite has had notice of Newell's patents, and Decorite's infringement of Newell's patents is willful and deliberate.
 - 17. This is an exceptional case under 35 U.S.C. § 285.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, as a result of the unlawful acts of Decorite set forth herein, Newell prays for:

A. the entry of judgment that Newell is the owner of the `707, `405, `202, `795, `248, `387, and `388 Patents;

B. the entry of judgment that Decorite has infringed, and continues to infringe, the

'707, '405, '202, '795, '248, '387, and '388 Patents;

C. an injunction prohibiting Decorite, and all persons in concert and participation

with it, from using, making, importing, using, offering for sale, and selling knobs and pulls that

embody the designs described and shown in the '707, '405, '202, '795, '248, '387, and '388

Patents;

D. an award of damages adequate to compensate Newell for Decorite's infringement

of the '707, '405, '202, '795, '248, '387, and '388 Patents, including disgorgement of Decorite's

profits;

E. an award that trebles the amount of actual damages assessed against Decorite and

in favor of Newell pursuant to 35 U.S.C. § 284;

F. an award of reasonable attorney fees and costs pursuant to 35 U.S.C. § 285; and

G. such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.

JURY DEMAND

Newell respectfully requests a trial by jury as to all issues so triable.


















