COMPLAINT

PLAINTIFF, Wireless Spectrum Technologies, Inc. ("WST") for its Complaint against Nortel Networks, Inc. ("Nortel") alleges as follows:

- 1. This is an action for violation of the Patent Laws of the United States, Title 35, United States Code. Jurisdiction is in this Court under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1332 and 1338 (a). Venue is proper in this Court under 28 U.S.C §§1391(b) (c) and § 1400(b). The matter in controversy exceeds the sum or value of \$75,000 exclusive of costs and interest.
- 2. WST is a corporation organized under the laws of the state of Illinois and having its principal offices in 19 Court of Island, Northbrook, Illinois, 60062.
- 3. Upon information and belief, Nortel is a corporation organized under the laws of the state of Delaware with Central Region offices at 475 N. Martingale Road, Schaumburg, IL 60173.
- 4. On April 5, 1988, United States Patent No. 4, 736,453 ("the '453 patent"), a copy of which is attached as Attachment A, entitled "Method and Apparatus for Making Frequency

Channel Assignment in a Cellular or Non-Cellular Radiotelephone Communications System "duly and legally issued to inventor Gerald R. Schloermer.

- 5. WST is the assignee of the '453 patent with full rights to sue for past and current infringement of, and to enjoin the future infringement of the '453 patent.
- 6. On or about March 26, 1998, WST timely gave defendant Nortel notice of the '453 patent and from that date, WST has sought information that would assist WST in confirming whether Nortel's adaptive channel allocation products are within the lawful scope of one or more claims of the '453 patent.
- 7. On or about June 5, 2000, Nortel provided a single chapter entitled "Feature Description" of the operating manual of one of its adaptive channel allocation products, the DMS/MTX Adaptive Channel Allocation Deployment Guide for WST's review.
- 8. Pursuant to agreement between Nortel and WST, WST provided Nortel in July 2000 with a claim chart reading claims 1 and 11 of the '453 patent upon the Feature Description chapter of the DMS/MTX Adaptive Channel Allocation Deployment Guide prepared by WST experts William Anderson and Leo Aubel.
- 9. With the exception of the above noted Feature Description, despite WST's requests for additional information, Nortel has provided no information about the operation of its adaptive channel allocation products.
- 10. Upon information and belief, WST is unaware of any technique by which it can analyze Nortel's adaptive channel allocation products. Purchase of the appropriate products is impractical because the product's costs are beyond the meager budget of a small startup corporation like WST. In the absence of responses from Nortel, WST resorts to the judicial process and the aid of discovery to obtain under appropriate judicial safeguards such information

as is required to confirm their belief and to present the Court with evidence that each and every of Nortel's adaptive channel allocation products infringe one or more claims of the '453 patent.

- 11. Upon information and belief, defendant Nortel has been and still is guilty of infringement, contributory infringement and/or inducing infringement of WST's '453 patent within this district by making, using, importing, selling or offering for sale its adaptive channel allocation products including but not limited to software for channel assignment and/or handoff in the Motorola iDEN system, and/or software used in the Fuzzy Logic and/or Adaptive Channel Allocation or Channel Assignment for cellular radio products and other cellular systems embodying the patented invention of the '453 patent without leave or license from WST, all to WST's substantial damage.
- 12. Upon information and belief, defendant Nortel has committed and will continue to commit the aforesaid acts of infringement intentionally in a willful and deliberate manner unless enjoined by this Court.
- 13. This is an exceptional case within the meaning of Title 35 United States Code Section 285.
- 14. WST is suffering irreparable injury caused by defendant Nortel's acts of infringement.

WHEREFORE Wireless Spectrum Technologies, Inc. prays that this Court:

- (a) adjudge United States Patent No. 4,736,453 valid, enforceable, and infringed by defendant Nortel;
- (b) preliminarily and permanently enjoin defendant Nortel, its officers, agents, servants, employees and all those in active concert or participation with them

from all acts of infringement, contributory infringement or inducing infringement of United States Patent No. 4,736,453;

- order defendant Nortel to account for damages sustained as a result of their acts of infringement, contributory infringement or inducing infringement of said letter patent, with interest, such damage so found then to be increased threefold;
- (d) award WST its costs, expenses and reasonable attorney's fees for bringing and prosecuting this action; and
- (e) award WST such other and further relief as the Court may deem to be just and proper.
