COMPLAINT FOR DECLARATORY JUDGMENT

JURY DEMAND

Plaintiff, Fluke Corporation ("Fluke"), complains against the Defendant, Cary Ratner ("Ratner"), as follows:

#### **THE PARTIES**

- 1. Fluke is a Delaware corporation having a principal place of business at 6920 Seaway Blvd., Everett, Washington 98203. Fluke is a leader in the manufacture, distribution, and service of electronic test tools and software.
- 2. On information and belief, Ratner is an individual residing in East Hills, New York.

#### JURISDICTION AND VENUE

- 3. This action arises under the patent laws of the United States, Title 35, United States Code. Jurisdiction is invoked pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1331 and 1338(a), and the Federal Declaratory Judgment Act, 28 U.S.C. §§ 2201 and 2202 for a declaratory judgment of non-infringement and invalidity of United States Patent No. D554,152, entitled "Ergonomic Pressure Calibration Pump" ("the '152 patent"). A copy of the '152 patent is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 4. This action is based upon an actual and continuing controversy between the parties with respect to the noninfringement and invalidity of the '152 patent.
- 5. This Court has personal jurisdiction over Ratner based upon his contacts with the State of Washington, including his purposeful contacts in the State of Washington with Fluke relating to the '152 patent.
  - 6. Venue in this Court is proper based upon 28 U.S.C. §§ 1391 and 1400 (b).

#### BACKGROUND FACTS

- 7. Fluke is a leader in the manufacture, distribution, and service of electronic test tools and software. Fluke designs, manufactures, markets, and sells electronic test tools and software, including parts for electronic test tools. By way of example, Fluke offers for sale pressure calibration pumps.
- 8. On November 16, 2007, Ratner sent a cease and desist letter to Fluke, asserting that Fluke was infringing a patent allegedly owned by Ratner. (See Exhibit B). More specifically, Ratner alleged that he is the owner of the '152 patent, and that Fluke was infringing the '152

patent. Ratner demanded that Fluke cease and desist selling the products accused of infringement.

- 9. Based upon at least Ratner's claim of alleged infringement of the '152 patent,
  Ratner has demonstrated an intention and willingness to assert the patent rights he claims to have
  in design features of pressure calibration pumps against Fluke.
- 10. Accordingly, Fluke has an apprehension that Ratner will file suit against it for infringement of the '152 patent.

# FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION DECLARATION OF NON-INFRINGEMENT OF <u>UNITED STATES PATENT NO. D554,152</u>

- 11. Fluke hereby incorporates paragraphs 1 10 above as if fully set out herein.
- 12. An actual controversy exists between Ratner and Fluke regarding the non-infringement of the '152 patent. Unless prevented through this Declaratory Judgment action, Ratner will continue to wrongfully assert the '152 patent against Fluke.
- 13. Fluke has not infringed, either directly, indirectly, contributorily, or by inducement, or in any other way, any claim of the '152 patent, either literally or under the doctrine of equivalents, willfully or otherwise.
- 14. Fluke is entitled to a declaratory judgment that the '152 patent is not infringed by Fluke.

#### SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION DECLARATION OF INVALIDITY OF UNITED STATES PATENT NO. D554,152

15. Fluke hereby incorporates paragraphs 1 - 14 above as if fully set out herein.

COMPLAINT FOR DECLARATORY JUDGMENT – 3

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- 16. An actual controversy exists between Ratner and Fluke regarding the invalidity of the '152 patent. Unless prevented through this Declaratory Judgment action, Ratner will continue to wrongfully assert the '152 patent against Fluke.
- 17. The '152 patent is invalid for failure to comply with the requirements of Title 35, United States Code, including but not limited to Sections 102, 103, 112 and/or 171.
- 18. The '152 patent is invalid in part because the design features it claims are functional, obvious, and not novel or new.
  - 19. Fluke is entitled to a declaratory judgment that the '152 patent is invalid.

#### PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff Fluke Corporation demands:

- A. A judgment be entered declaring that the '152 patent is invalid;
- B. A judgment be entered declaring that neither Fluke nor any of its customers have infringed the '152 patent;
- C. This case be adjudged and decreed exceptional and Fluke be awarded its costs and attorneys fees in defending this action; and
  - D. For such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.

#### **JURY DEMAND**

Plaintiff Fluke Corporation hereby requests trial by jury of all issues so triable.





Since the Fluke Corporation has neglected to respond to my letter dated August 20, 2007 (Please see attachment) I am sending the following update and final notice.

On October 30, 2007, I was formally granted a Design Patent (number D554152) which is for an "Ergonomic Pressure Calibration Pump". As you are aware from my earlier correspondence, the Martel pump handles incorporated this "ergonomic" design thus infringing on my patent. By Fluke selling and marketing this product in its current form, you are infringing upon both my US and International patents.
