INTRODUCTION

This is an action by plaintiff Henry-Griffitts, Inc. for patent infringement against defendants

Acushnet Company d/b/a Titleist Golf, Roger Cleveland Golf Company, Inc. and Taylor Made Golf

Company.

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

- 1. This action arises under the United States Patent Laws, 35 U.S.C. § 101, et seq. This Court has subject matter jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1331 and 1338(a).
 - 2. Venue is proper before this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1391 and/or § 1400.

PARTIES

3. Plaintiff Henry-Griffitts, Inc. is a Idaho corporation with a place of business at 827 W. Prairie Avenue, Hayden Lake, ID 83835.

ORIGINAL COMPLAINT FOR PATENT INFRINGEMENT AND DEMAND FOR JURY TRIAL

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- 4. Defendant Acushnet Company, Inc. d/b/a Titleist Golf, is a Delaware corporation with a place of business at 2819 Loker Ave E, Carlsbad, CA, and is doing business and committing acts of patent infringement in this judicial district and elsewhere.
- 5. Defendant Roger Cleveland Golf Company, Inc. is a California corporation with a place of business at 5630 Cerritos Avenue, Cypress, California 90630, and is doing business and committing acts of patent infringement in this judicial district and elsewhere.
- 6. Defendant Taylor Made Golf Company, Inc. is a Delaware corporation with a place of business at 3345 Fermi Ct., Carlsbad, California, 92008, and is doing business and committing acts of patent infringement in this judicial district and elsewhere.

COUNT: PATENT INFRINGEMENT

- 7. The allegations of paragraphs 1-6 above are incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.
- 8. Plaintiff Henry-Griffitts, Inc. is the owner by assignment of U.S. Patent No. 4,932,662 ("the '662 patent"), which was duly and legally issued on June 12, 1990 and is entitled "GOLF CLUB LIE ANGLE EVALUATION DEVICE".
- 9. In violation of one or more provisions of 35 U.S.C. § 271, each of the Defendants has infringed, and continues to infringe, one or more of the claims of the '662 patent by making, using, importing, selling and/or offering for lie angle evaluation products in this judicial district and elsewhere.
 - 10. Defendants' acts of infringement have been and are willful.

11. Defendants' acts of infringement have caused and are causing reparable and irreparable damage to Plaintiff, and Plaintiff will continue to suffer damage unless Defendants are enjoined.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff prays that the Court:

- A. Enter judgment that Defendants have infringed U.S. Patent No. 4,932,662;
- B. Enter judgment that Defendants' acts of patent infringement have been and are willful;
- C. Temporarily, preliminarily and permanently enjoin Defendants, their parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, divisions, officers, agents, servants, employees, directors, partners, representatives, and all other persons in active concert and/or participating with them, from engaging in the aforesaid unlawful acts of infringement;
- D. Order Defendants to account for and pay to Plaintiff all damages caused to Plaintiff by Defendants' unlawful acts;
- E. Award Plaintiff increased damages and attorney fees pursuant to 35 U.S.C. §§ 284 and 285;
 - F. Award Plaintiff its interest and costs incurred in this action; and
- E. Grant Plaintiff such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.

DEMAND FOR JURY TRIALS

Plaintiff demands a jury trial of all issues triable of right by jury.
