## **COMPLAINT**

NOW COMES Plaintiff, Paint Rock Designs, LLC, by and through its attorneys, and for its Complaint against Defendant, Louis McCutcheon, Inc., states as follows:

### **PARTIES**

- 1. Plaintiff, Paint Rock Designs, LLC is a Texas limited liability company, having its principal place of business in Weatherford, Texas.
- 2. Defendant, Louis McCutcheon Inc., is a California corporation, and upon information and belief, does business as Dressage Extensions, and sells horse wear items as well as other equine related items. Agent for service of process is Louis McCutcheon, 27501 Cumberland Road, Tehachapi, California, 93561-9612.

#### **JURISDICTION AND VENUE**

- 3. This is an action for infringement of a United States patent. The court has jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. §1338(a).
- 4. Defendant does business in Texas. Defendant advertises on the internet via a website and does catalog sales. Defendant is advertising, selling and offering for

sale the infringing product, a horse blanket, "the blanket," in Texas. Venue is proper in this district under 28 U.S.C. §1400(b).

#### PATENT INFRINGEMENT

- 5. The blanket being sold and distributed by Defendant doing business as Dressage Extensions infringes on U.S. Patent No. 6,877,300 B1 ("Patent") issued on April 12, 2005 to H. Glen Hathcock. The Patent relates to a horse blanket used to help keep a horse warm in cold weather.
- 6. Plaintiff is the exclusive licensee of the Patent. Plaintiff has manufactured and sold a horse blanket through the license exactly like the blanket sold by the Defendant.
  - 7. Defendant has actual notice of the Patent.
- 8. Defendant is infringing the patent by making, using, selling and offering to sell the blanket in the channels of commerce.
- 9. Defendant will continue to infringe unless enjoined by the Court. Plaintiff has suffered damages due to Defendant's infringing activities.
  - 10. Defendant's infringement is willful, making this an exceptional case.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff, respectfully prays this Court to enter Judgment in Plaintiff's favor and against Defendant, as follows:

- Defendant be preliminarily and permanently enjoined from infringing U.S. A. Patent No. 6,877,300 B1 in any manner:
- B. Defendant be ordered to deliver up for destruction all blankets that infringe the Patent and any advertising offering the blanket for sale or distribution;

- C. Defendant be ordered to pay Plaintiff's actual damages for infringing the Patent;
- Defendant be ordered to pay Plaintiff three (3) times the amount of actual D. damages for willfully infringing the Patent;
- Defendant be ordered to pay interest, costs and attorneys' fees to Plaintiff; E. and
- F. Such further and other relief be granted to Plaintiff as may be just and equitable in the circumstances.
