PLAINTIFF'S ORIGINAL COMPLAINT

Plaintiff Sonic Industry, LLC ("Plaintiff"), by and through its undersigned counsel, files this Original Complaint against TradeKing, LLC ("Defendant"), as follows:

NATURE OF THE ACTION

1. This is a patent infringement action to stop Defendant's infringement of Plaintiff's United States Patent No. 5,954,793 entitled "Remote Limit-Setting Information System" (the "'793 patent"; a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A). Plaintiff is the exclusive licensee of the '793 patent with respect to the Defendant. Plaintiff seeks injunctive relief and monetary damages.

PARTIES

- 5. The Court has personal jurisdiction over Defendant because: Defendant is present within or has minimum contacts with the State of California and the Central District of California; Defendant has purposefully availed itself of the privileges of conducting business in the State of

- 6. More specifically, Defendant, directly and/or through authorized intermediaries, ships, distributes, offers for sale, sells, and/or advertises (including the provision of an interactive web page) its products and services in the United States, the State of California, and the Central District of California. Plaintiff is the exclusive licensee of the '793 patent with respect to the Defendant, and possesses all rights of recovery under the '793 patent with respect to the Defendant, including the right to sue for infringement and recover past damages.
- 9. Plaintiff is informed and believes that Defendant owns, operates, advertises, controls, sells, and otherwise provides hardware and software for "remotely setting limits on an

- 10. Defendant's aforesaid activities have been without authority and/or license from Plaintiff.
- 11. Plaintiff is entitled to recover from the Defendant the damages sustained by Plaintiff as a result of the Defendant's wrongful acts in an amount subject to proof at trial, which, by law, cannot be less than a reasonable royalty, together with interest and costs as fixed by this Court under 35 U.S.C. § 284.
- 12. Defendant's infringement of Plaintiff's exclusive rights under the '793 patent will continue to damage Plaintiff, causing irreparable harm for which there is no adequate remedy at law, unless enjoined by this Court.

JURY DEMAND

13. Plaintiff hereby requests a trial by jury pursuant to Rule 38 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.
