Plaintiff realizes that this Notice of Appeal may be premature; however, the case law and the Rules are rather vague on this point; as, this Action is after final judgment and Mandate. Therefore, it is under an abundance of caution that Plaintiff files this Notice of Appeal.

Plaintiff does understand that, if he does not withdraw this Appeal at a later date, this will be the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) appeal in this Action; and, Plaintiff apologizes for that. Plaintiff very much appreciates any understanding that the Court may have for events and Plaintiff's most unfortunate position; as well as, his need to protect himself.
