16 **COMPLAINT FOR PATENT INFRINGEMENT**

17 Plaintiff Eclipse IP LLC (“Eclipse”), by counsel, complains of defendant Toyota  
18 Motor Sales, U.S.A., Inc. (“Toyota”), as follows:

19 **NATURE OF LAWSUIT**

20 1. This is a suit for patent infringement arising under the patent laws of the  
21 United States, Title 35 of the United States Code § 1 *et seq.* This Court has exclusive  
22 jurisdiction over the subject matter of the Complaint under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1331 and  
23 1338(a).

24 **PARTIES AND PATENTS**

25 2. Eclipse is a company organized and existing under the laws of Florida and  
26 having a principal place of business address at 115 NW 17th Street, Delray Beach,  
27 Florida 33444.

1 3. Eclipse owns all right, title, and interest in and has standing to sue for

25 others of one or more claims of the ‘952 patent through, among other activities,  
26 continuing to manufacture, distribute, and sell vehicles equipped with the infringing  
27 navigation systems to its customers after having received notice of its infringement of  
28 the ‘952 patent.

1 10. Toyota has knowingly infringed one or more claims of the '900 patent  
2 through, among other activities, the use of navigation systems in its vehicles to:  
3 schedule notifications relating to arrival or departure of the vehicle; monitor traffic flow  
4 predicament data relating to a vehicle's intended route; and determine whether or not to  
5 reschedule notifications based upon such data.

6 11. Toyota has actively induced and/or contributed to the infringement by  
7 others of one or more claims of the '900 patent through, among other activities,  
8 continuing to manufacture, distribute, and sell vehicles equipped with the infringing  
9 navigation systems to its customers after having received notice of its infringement of  
10 the '900 patent.

11 12. Through direct, induced, and contributory infringement Toyota has injured  
12 Eclipse, and Eclipse is entitled to recover damages adequate to compensate it for such  
13 infringement, but in no event less than a reasonable royalty.

27 has infringed and continues to infringe claims of the '952 patent, literally and/or under

2 the '952 patent, and/or has actively induced and continues to actively induce others to

5 **COUNT II**

9 paragraphs 1 through 15 above and incorporates them by reference.

10 17. On January 20, 2009, United States Patent No. 7,479,900, entitled  
11 "Notification Systems and Methods that Consider Traffic Flow Predicament Data" was  
12 duly and legally issued by the United States Patent and Trademark Office. Eclipse IP is  
13 the owner of the entire right, title and interest in and to the '900 patent. A true and  
14 correct copy of the '900 patent is attached as Exhibit B to this complaint.

15 18. Eclipse is informed and believes, and thereupon alleges, that Toyota: (1)  
16 has infringed and continues to infringe claims of the '900 patent, literally and/or under  
17 the doctrine of equivalents, and/or (2) has contributed and continues to contribute to the  
18 literal infringement and/or infringement under the doctrine of equivalents of claims of  
19 the '900 patent, and/or has actively induced and continues to actively induce others to  
20 infringe claims of the '900 patent, literally and/or under the doctrine of equivalents, in  
21 this district and elsewhere in the United States.

22 **PRAYER FOR RELIEF**

23 WHEREFORE, Plaintiff Eclipse asks this Court to enter judgment against the  
24 defendant and against each of the defendant's respective subsidiaries, affiliates, agents,  
25 servants, employees and all persons in active concert or participation with it, granting  
26 the following relief:

6 Toyota’s willful infringement, and reasonable attorneys’ fees and costs; and,



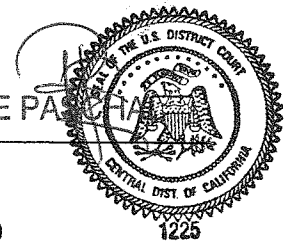
